



UK & EU REACH Compliance Statement

Really Useful Products Ltd

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About REACH

REACH is Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals. It is the European Union's primary regulation on chemicals and their safe use, and entered into force on 1 June 2007.

Following the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union, EU REACH was brought into UK law under the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018. The UK regime, known as UK REACH, came into force on 1 January 2021.

Under REACH, suppliers of articles must provide recipients with sufficient information to allow safe use of the article, including, as a minimum, the name of any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) on the Candidate List present in the article in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w). This 0.1% (w/w) threshold is assessed at the level of each individual article. Where a product is made up of more than one article (for example, an assembly of separate components), the threshold applies separately to each component article, in line with the principle that an article retains its status as an article when incorporated into a complex product ("once an article, always an article").

About Our Business

Really Useful Products Ltd are converters of plastic granules into plastic storage boxes. Our products are "articles" within the meaning of REACH; they are not intended to release substances under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use and, as such, do not require registration under REACH. The Company is a downstream user and works closely with its supply chain to ensure ongoing compliance with all applicable chemical regulatory requirements.

UK REACH Compliance

Based on information provided by our suppliers, and to the best of our knowledge and belief having exercised reasonable care, the products we place on the UK market comply with the requirements of UK REACH. None of the substances currently listed on the UK REACH Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs), as maintained by the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) as the UK REACH Agency, are present in any individual article comprising our products in a concentration above 0.1% (w/w).

Our products also comply with the applicable restrictions in Annex XVII to UK REACH and contain no substances on the UK REACH Authorisation List (Annex XIV) that would require authorisation. As no SVHC is present in any article above 0.1% (w/w) and/or the relevant tonnage threshold of one tonne per producer or importer per year is not met, no notification to the HSE under Article 7(2) of UK REACH is required.

EU REACH Compliance

Really Useful Products Ltd recognises and complies with its responsibilities under Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (EU REACH). Based on information provided by our suppliers, and to the best of our knowledge and belief having exercised reasonable care, none of the substances on the EU REACH Candidate List of SVHCs, as published by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), are present in any individual article comprising our products in a concentration above 0.1% (w/w).

Our products also comply with the applicable restrictions in Annex XVII to EU REACH and contain no substances on the EU REACH Authorisation List (Annex XIV) requiring authorisation. As no SVHC is present in any article above 0.1% (w/w) and/or the relevant tonnage threshold of one tonne per producer or importer per year is not met, no notification to ECHA under Article 7(2) of EU REACH is required. Should any SVHC be present above 0.1% (w/w), the Company would also fulfil any applicable notification to the SCIP database maintained by ECHA under the EU Waste Framework Directive.

Sourcing and SVHCs

All virgin plastic and colourants used in our manufacturing processes are purchased from suppliers within Europe and comply with existing and pending UK and EU/European chemical safety legislation. The Company does not knowingly use any Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) in the manufacture of its products.

Our Ongoing Commitments

Really Useful Products Ltd is committed to the following:

- Monitoring the ECHA SVHC Candidate List (<https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>) and the UK REACH Candidate List for any updates that may affect our products;
- Working closely with our suppliers to ensure continued compliance across our supply chain;

- Obtaining and documenting our suppliers' REACH compliance statements as they become available;
- Notifying customers promptly if any SVHC is identified as being present in our products in a concentration above 0.1% (w/w);
- Communicating safe-use information where required;
- Providing supporting documentation to customers upon request;
- Reviewing and updating this statement periodically to reflect changes in applicable legislation and the Candidate Lists.

This statement is based on information provided by our suppliers and on data available within our supply chain and is given to the best of the Company's knowledge and belief having exercised reasonable care. It is not a warranty or guarantee and is provided without liability beyond the exercise of reasonable care.
